We are updating the binding moratorium to include coastal North Carolina. The moratorium will remain in place for the counties listed in Northeast Florida, Georgia, South Carolina.

This moratorium applies to Property, Inland Marine, Ocean Marine, Environmental Property, Auto Dealers/Garage Physical Damage and Garagekeepers business. This moratorium applies to the binding of any new business as well as new additions and/or exposure or limit increases to existing policies. We ask that you immediately advise all your agency personnel of this suspension.

**Binding Authority remains suspended for the following counties:**

## Georgia:

Brantley, Bryan, Camden, Charlton, Chatham, Effingham, Glynn, Liberty, Long, McIntosh, Wayne

## **South Carolina:**

Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dillon, Dorchester, Georgetown, Hampton, Horry, Jasper, Marion, Williamsburg

We are reinstating binding authority for the counties in Florida not listed above.
