Due to the Bond Fire, Airport Fire and Cerritos Fire, all binding authority is temporarily suspended for Property, Inland Marine, Environmental Property, Ocean Marine, Auto Dealers/Garage Physical Damage and Garagekeepers business.

This moratorium applies to the binding of any new business as well as new additions and/or exposure or limits increases to existing policies. We ask that you immediately advise all your agency personnel of this suspension. This moratorium applies to all perils.

If you have a risk in this area, you may contact your underwriter to consider an exception.
