Due to the approaching Hurricane Elsa, projected to affect Florida, all binding authority is temporarily suspended for Property, Inland Marine, Environmental Property, Ocean Marine, Auto Dealers/Garage Physical Damage and Garagekeepers business.

This moratorium applies to the binding of any new business, as well as new additions, and/or exposure or limit increases to existing policies. We ask that you immediately advise all your agency personnel of this suspension.

This moratorium applies to the entire state of Florida.

This moratorium applies to all perils.

If you have a risk in this area, you may contact your underwriter to consider an exception.

Once the hurricane has passed or been downgraded, we will notify you to lift the suspension.
